



INFORMATION ON THE RIGHT OF RESIDENCE OPPORTUNITIES



ON 31.12.2022, THE RIGHT OF RESIDENCE OPPORTUNITIES (§104C RESIDENCE ACT) CAME INTO EFFECT. INDIVIDUALS WHO HAVE LIVED IN GERMANY FOR A LONG TIME AND ARE CURRENTLY ONLY TOLERATED ARE THUS GIVEN THE OPPORTUNITY TO SECURE THEIR RESIDENCE FOR THE LONG-TERM.

 Persons who: > Have been living in Germany for five years as of 31 October 2022 > Have tolerated stay status (Duldung) > Have not been sentenced to more than 50 daily rates (general criminal cases) or 90 daily rates (criminal cases under immigration law) > Have not repeatedly and intentionally prevented their deportation 	 > The application for an opportunity residence permit must be submitted to the immigration office > The opportunity residence permit is issued for 18 months and cannot be extended How do you submit an application for an opportunity residence permit to Wuppertal Immigration Office? > The application form is available here: > Please send signed, completed applications to the following Email: Chancenaufenthaltsrecht@stadt.wuppertal.de 	 > During these 18 months, you will have an unrestricted work permit and be allowed to attend an integration course > This 18-month period will give you time to meet the requirements for long-term residency. These requirements include: Providing proof of German language skills (speaking A2), securing the livelihood and identity clarification
